Dear Adakhamjon,

Welcome to SUNY Plattsburgh! We expect that you will make many valuable contributions to our campus and community. Therefore, you have been awarded a financial aid package in the amount of **\$ 13,500 USD per academic year (\$ 6,750 USD per semester)**. Your financial award package includes the following:

- \$6,000 Merit-based Scholarship** (renewable - \$3,000 per semester) to retain this award, you must fulfill the following obligations:
 - enroll as a full-time, undergraduate, international student holding a valid student visa
 - pay non-resident tuition and fees
 - maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or better
- \$5,000 International Campus Community Award** (renewable - \$2,500 per semester) To retain this award, you must fulfill the following obligations:
 - enroll as a full-time, undergraduate, international student holding a valid student visa
 - pay non-resident tuition and fees
 - live on campus sharing a double-occupancy room
 - maintain minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better
- \$2,500 Global Diversity Award** (renewable - \$1,250 per semester) to retain this award, you must fulfill the following obligations:
 - enroll as a full-time, undergraduate, international student holding a valid student visa
 - pay non-resident tuition and fees
 - maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better

Please note that the billed cost of attendance (see enclosed bill estimate) increases approximately four percent (4%) each academic year. In addition, you can anticipate that you will spend \$2,000 to \$3,000 each year for unbilled costs such as books, transportation, clothing, entertainment, etc.

You should not expect that additional financial aid from our institution will become available. Also, students studying in the U.S. on student visas (F or J) cannot be considered New York State residents and will never be eligible for in-state, residential tuition. Therefore, as you plan to begin your studies at Plattsburgh, you and your family need to consider the costs of attendance for your entire length of study here so that you can complete your studies at Plattsburgh without interruption.

We hope that you will accept our offer. I look forward to welcoming you personally to SUNY Plattsburgh.

P.S. A limited number of on-campus jobs are available for international students. International students may not work off campus. If you are able to find on-campus employment, you can expect to earn about \$9.75 per hour and to work approximately 8 to 10 hours each week. You should not expect to pay any of your billed costs with money earned through on-campus employment. The money that you earn can be used to pay for unbilled costs (e.g., books, entertainment, etc.).
