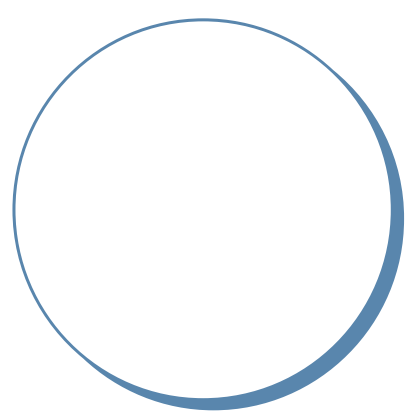

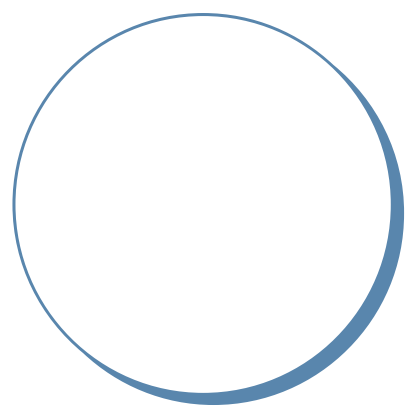
Leaving the campus

- 1.Students must stay on campus overnight between 7 pm and 9 am with no exception.
- 2. Sudents must check in with program leaders each evening between 6-7pm.
- 63. Students are allowed to leave the campus between 9 am and 7 pm without program leaders supervision ONLY if parents selected such option. Students who have parents permission to leave the campus on their own must have active and charged cell phone and must inform the staff that they will be doing things on their own that day.

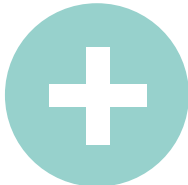

Other guidelines and responsibilities

- 1. To comply with all program rules.
- 2. During the program, students must remain on campus after 9 pm until 9 am.
Students must report to the program staff on duty between 8pm-9pm. Police will be notified immediately if the student is not present at check-in. Failure to report for check-in could result in the student's departure from the program.
- 3. Before leaving the residence hall, students MUST notify a program staffer and provide information regarding their destination and expected return time.
- 4. Students must attend all activities that they signed up for a day earlier.
- 5. Students must keep their room and personal belongings neat, clean, and orderly at all times. Students can eat in their rooms but leftovers must be disposed of as trash and all open food must be stored in the fridge.
- 6. Students are liable to pay the entire cost for repairs or replacements of damaged property. Students are required to report any potential damage immediately.
- 7. The consumption, possession, and/or sale of tobacco, alcohol, and controlled or illegal substances is strictly prohibited. There is a zero-tolerance policy for students in violation of this guideline. If found in violation of this guideline, the student(s) involved will be sent home immediately at their own cost.
- 8. The possession of a firearm, blade, explosive, dangerous chemical or weapon is strictly prohibited. There is a zero-tolerance policy for students found in violation of this guideline. If in violation, the student(s) involved will be sent home immediately at their own cost.
- 9. Male students are not permitted to enter female students' rooms and female students are not permitted to enter the male students' rooms. Excessive public displays of affection are disallowed.
- 10. Students are disallowed from engaging in intercourse for the duration of the program. If in violation, the student(s) involved will be sent home immediately at their own cost.
- 11. Students are required to engage in a respectful manner at all times. Students are forbidden from engaging in speech or other expressions, such as non-verbal symbols, directed at an individual's disability, gender, gender expression, nationality, race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or any other status protected by law. Students are forbidden from engaging in language which is obscene, libelous or slanderous, or which by their very utterance or expression are likely to incite a violent reaction as to create a clear and present danger of the commission of unlawful acts.
- 12. Verbal harassment, physical abuse or hazing or engaging in harassing or discriminatory behavior based on disability, gender, gender identity, gender expression, nationality, race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, or any other status protected by law, or the threat of any such physical abuse will not be tolerated.
- 13. Committing sexual harassment as defined by law or by District policies and procedures, which may include unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal, nonverbal, or physical conduct of a sexual nature.
- 14. Theft and/or robbery and computer-based crimes are disallowed.
- 15. It is forbidden to engage in intimidating conduct or bullying against another person through words or actions, including direct physical contact and verbal assaults.
- 16. Respect and listen to the program staff and residence hall staff.

MEDICAL RELEASE FORM
